The visitor centre complex for Lake Vyrnwy is by the dam on the B4393 Llanfyllin to Bala road.

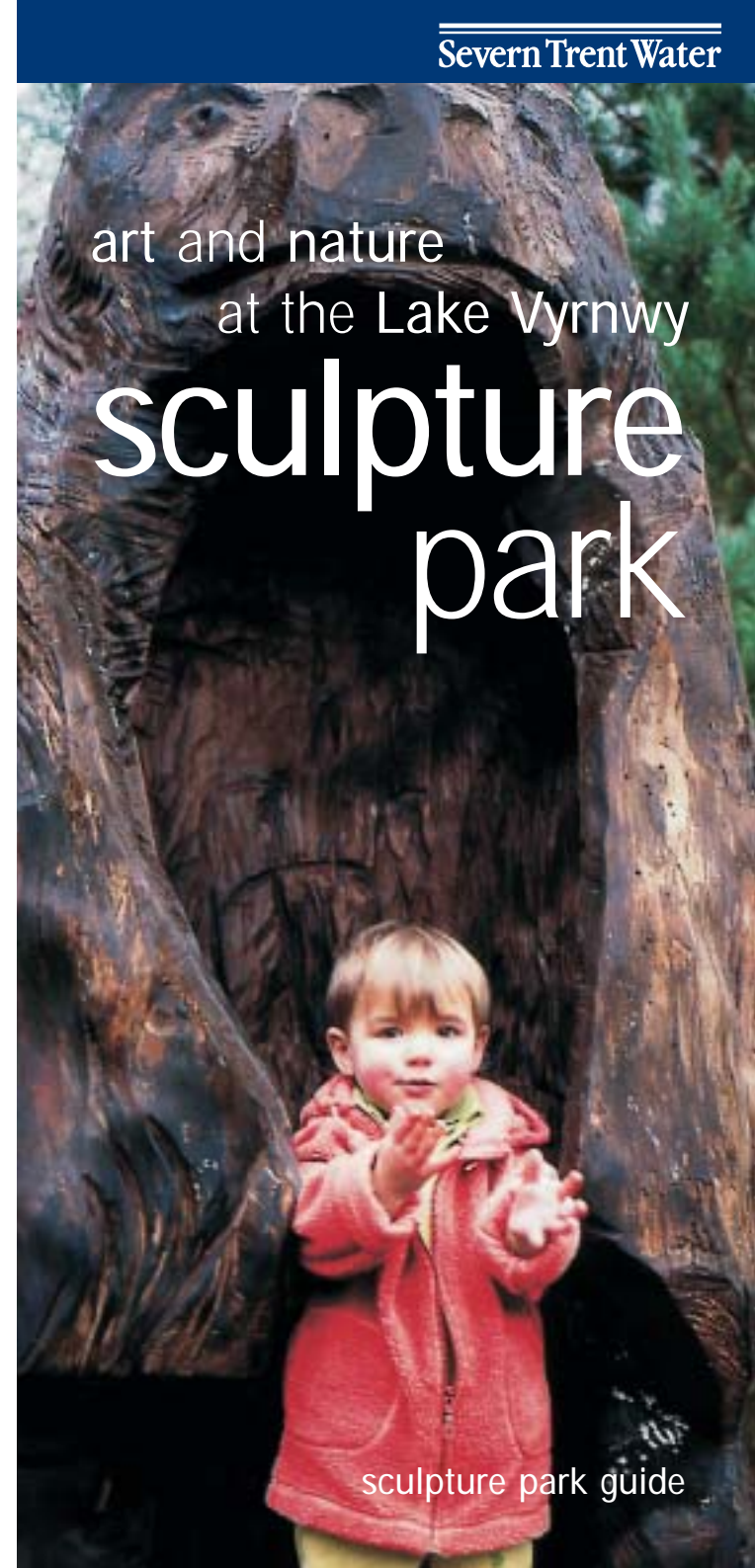
