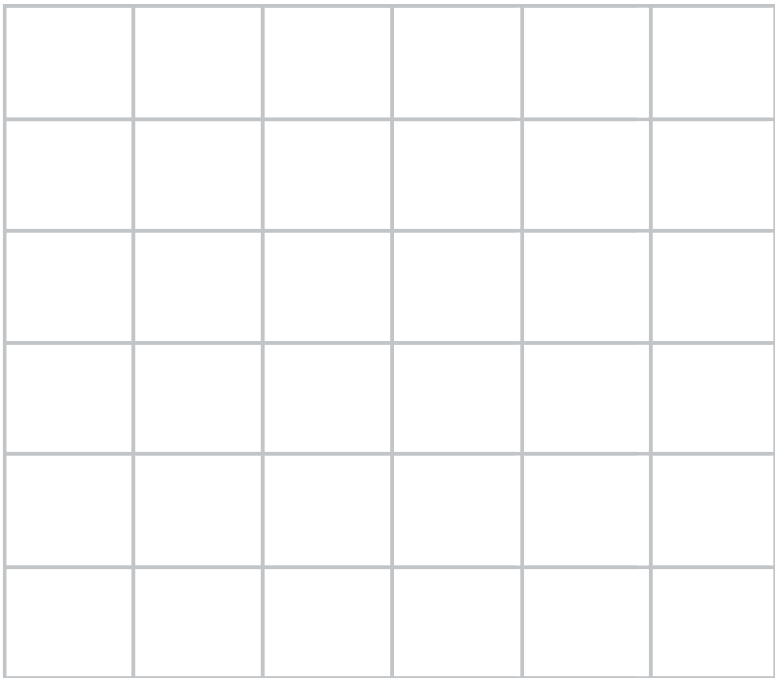
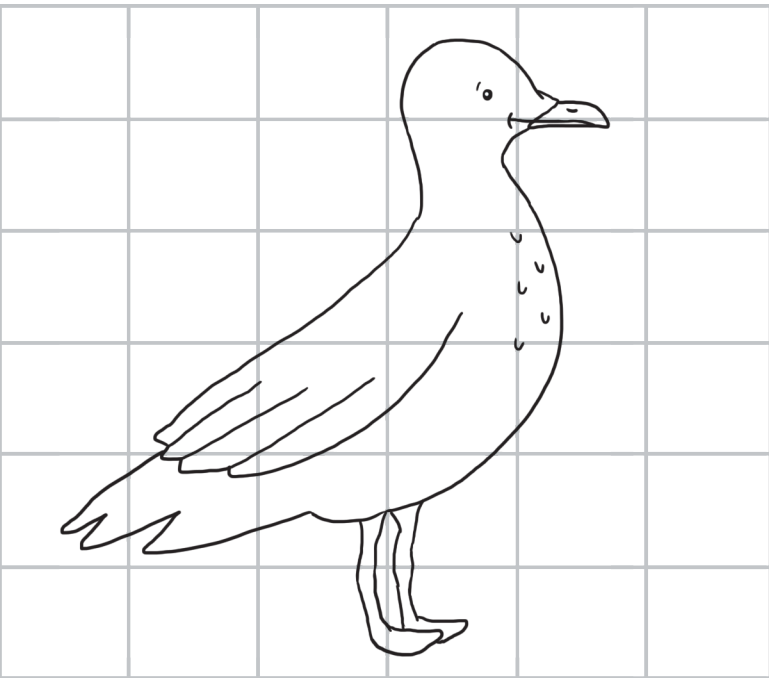
Lots of animals in the ocean environment are affected by plastic pollution.

TURTLES

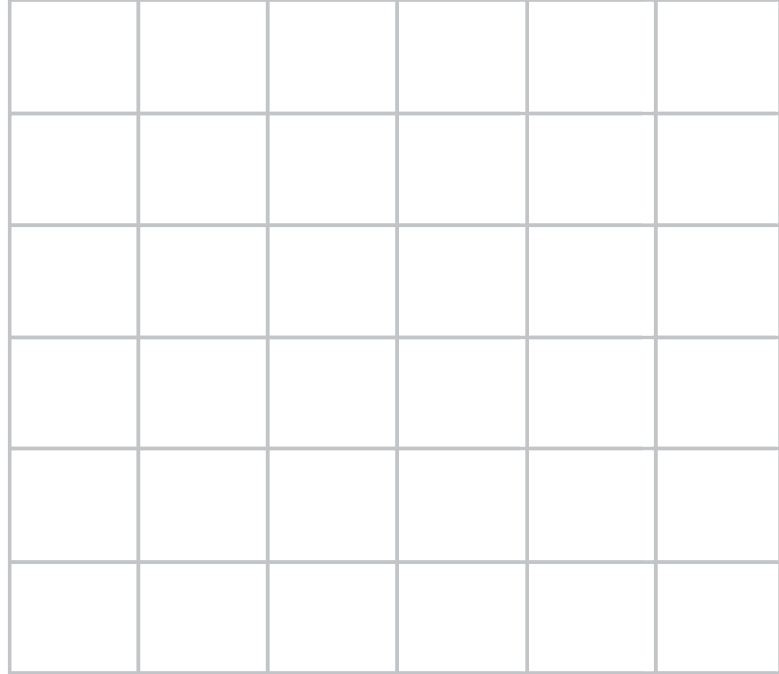
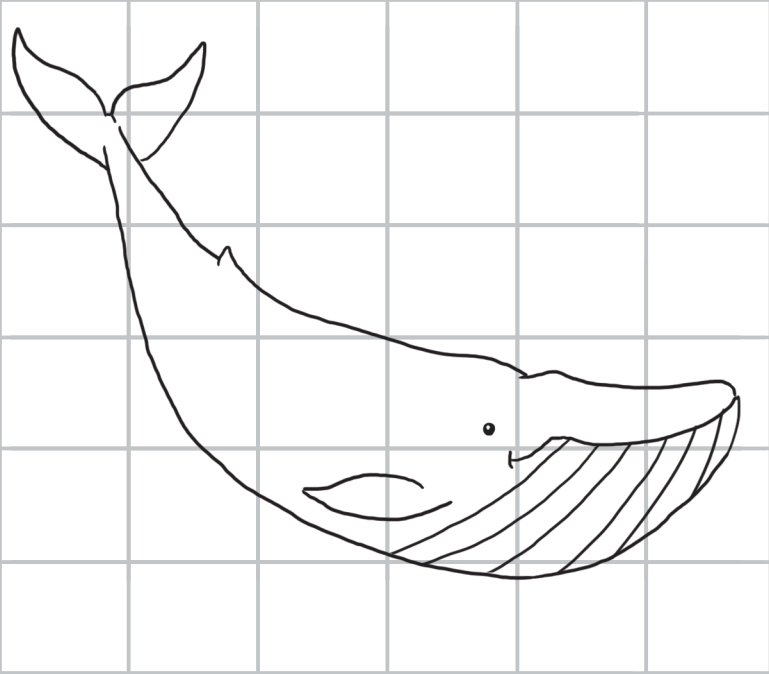
Plastic that is dumped in the ocean can harm turtles as they think it is food when it floats on the water. They eat the plastic and this can make them poorly and even kill the animals.



SEA BIRDS

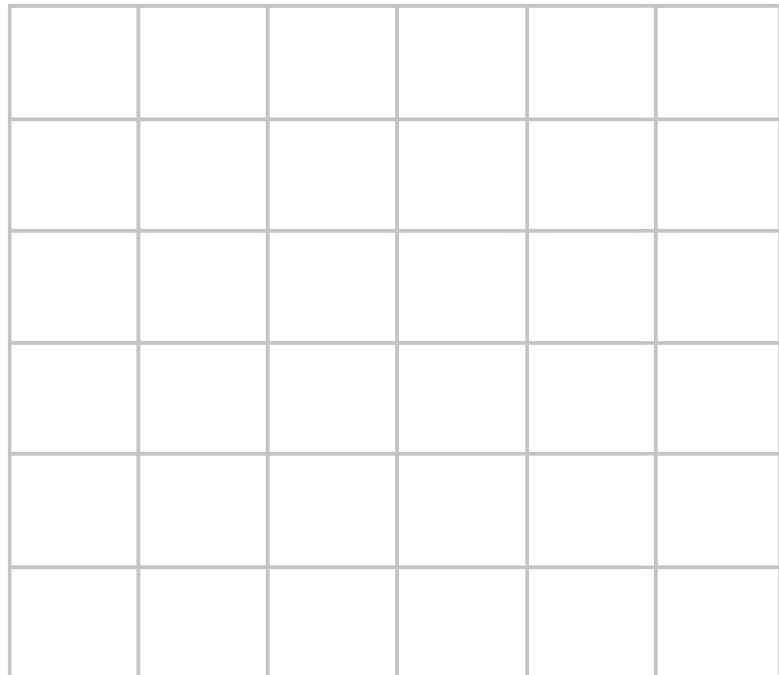
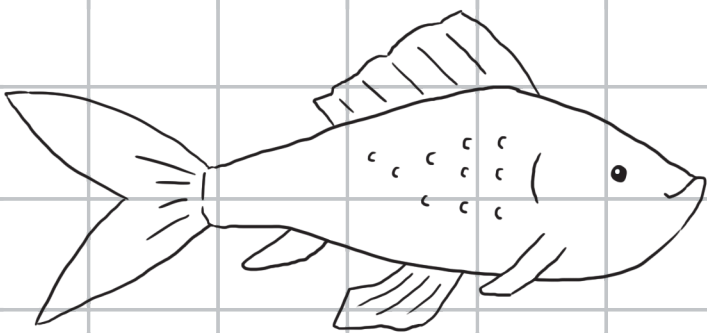
Did you know that 15% of a sea bird chick's body weight is plastic? Their nests are also likely to contain or be made entirely of plastic! Help by reducing your plastic usage!

WHALES

Did you know that nearly 58% of whales die from eating plastic? They mistake it for food! Every year up to 12.7 million tonnes of plastic enters our oceans, this weighs more than all the blue whales on earth put together!



FISH

Like whales, fish also mistake plastic for food. Plastic can take over 100 years to break down and turns into smaller pieces called microplastics. If we then eat fish the plastic can end up in our bodies too!

Over half the plastic in the ocean is single-use plastic, this means it can only be used once!
You can help by using a reusable water bottle instead of buying bottled water!
