MAKE YOUR OWN RAIN GAUGE

Did you know watering plants with a hose pipe could waste 500 litres of water in just half an hour!

Make a rain gauge to find out how much rain falls in your area and then use this water to

water your plants!


What you'll need:

- A plastic 2 litre bottle
- Scissors
- A measuring jug

What to do:

- **1.** Carefully cut through the top of the bottle and turn the top part upside down to make a funnel. (You may need an adult to help with this part.)
- **2.** Find an open space of ground away from trees and buildings. Dig a small hole to stand your rain gauge in.
- **3.** Check the rain gauge daily at the same time and pour the water into the measuring jug.
- 4. Write down how much rain fell each day.
- **5.** Once it is full use the water to water your plants both inside and outside!

TOP TIP: To use the rain gauge properly you must take the measurements at the same time each day!
