#### What you'll need

- An old plastic bottle
- Glue (PVA craft glue or a glue stick)
- Decorations (like felt, pom poms and googly eyes)
- Scissors

#### What to do:

- 1. Clean and remove any labels and dispose of the lid
- 2. Safely cut the bottle about a third of the way down (from the top), ask an adult for help when doing this.
- 3. Get the top bit and put it upside down in the bottom bit of the bottle this will be your funnel.
- 4. Decorate your new fat collector with a Christmas theme - why not make a santa, reindeer, elf or snowman? You could even include a message telling people to put used cooking fats, oils and grease in it, instead of down the sink.





Why make a fat collector? Around Christmas time, lots of people pour cooking fats, oils and grease (F.O.G) straight out of the pan into the sink. Over time, F.O.G can build up and go hard in our pipes which can cause a blockage!

Once the fats, oils and grease have cooled down, they can be poured into a container - just like your fat collector - and once full, scraped out into the bin.







Try this challenge with your family on Christmas day and tick each box once you've completed each step!


