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Section 1 Service connection charges

1.1 Application form fee

When you've completed the relevant application form please return it with the right application fee (shown below) and supporting plans showing the property location (i.e. ordnance survey extract).

Please note these are non-refundable fees for providing a quotation for new service connections that must be paid at the time you submit your application.

1.2 Requirements assessed

We'll visit the site to assess your requirements (including any potential Traffic Management costs), the impact this has on our network and what's required to complete the connection. We'll send you a breakdown of the costs for making the connection.

1.2.1 Infrastructure charges

Infrastructure charges are used to cover the cost of improving and maintaining our existing network

1.2.2 Water for construction

Please note, you'll be charged for 'water for construction' if:

- you're not using an existing metered supply
- the connection is a Large Diameter connection for a newly built domestic property
- the connection is a standard 25mm or 32mm for any newly built domestic property
- the connection is on any commercial property with a 25mm connection.
