To enable Severn Trent Water to process your application, please complete all sections and tick boxes on the following application form, with as much information as you can. We will acknowledge receipt of this form.

1. Introduction

With effect from 1 April 1996, Section 101A allows owners or occupiers of premises to request Severn Trent Water to provide a public sewer, for domestic purposes, where;

The sewer will serve more than one premise.

The premises are presently served by private drainage not directly or indirectly connected to an existing public sewer.

The existing drainage for dealing with sewage is giving, or is likely to give rise to adverse effects on the environment or amenity.

2. Costs

If the request is successful the public sewer will be provided at our cost.

You will be responsible for the cost and the future maintenance of your private connection to the public sewer.

The abandonment, and making safe, of the existing private drainage systems serving the premises will be the responsibility of, and at the cost of, individual premise occupiers or owners.

Once connected to public sewerage you will be liable for the sewerage infrastructure charge. Details will be provided on request.

Once your premises are connected to public sewerage you will become liable for annual sewerage charges. Details will be provided on request.

3. Application
