

PRESSED FLOWERS CARD MAKING



Materials Needed:

- Cardboard - A4 size
- Your chosen flowers
- Glue - PVA and glue spreader works best

Crafting your card:

- Take a nature walk or head into your own garden and pick some small flowers.
- Press your flowers by placing them inside the pages of a thick book for 3-4 days.
- Once your flowers and leaves are pressed and dry, carefully remove them from the book.
- Fold your card in half and decide if you want it portrait or landscape.
- Use your pressed flowers and leaves to make a design on the front of your card before gluing them on. Don't forget to leave room to write your message like 'Happy Birthday'.
- Once you're happy with the design, add glue to each area and carefully stick on your flowers.
- Wait for it to dry overnight, then finish by writing your message inside the card.

Whether it's a Birthday card, a Get Well Soon card or just a card to make someone smile, flower pressing makes special and personal cards - made by you!
