

# WRITE A TREE THEMED POEM



A **rhyme scheme** is the pattern of rhyme between lines of a poem. There are lots of different types of rhyme schemes. Rhyme schemes place words in some of all of the lines that rhyme with one another.

Follow the rhyme patterns below to create your own poem.

The wonderful trees are so **green**,  
They make the air lovely and **clean**,  
They grow so high and **tall**,  
They make you feel so **small**.

*This is called 'AABB' rhyming pattern*

The ending words of first two lines (A) rhyme with each other

The ending words of the last two lines (B) rhyme with each other.
